

Westport & Carters Beach Water Supply Trunk Main shutdown.

Buller District Council advise that because of the recent weather events, repairs are necessary to our water supply and they will be closing down the main trunk to Westport from 12.30pm– 7pm tomorrow. This means no water. School will open until 12.30pm and then those that can go home need to. While we can all bring a drink bottle, 260 children going to the toilet would not be pleasant or healthy. Buses will run as normal.

There will be no school lunches so if your child needs to stay at school, they need to bring a lunch.

Lunches/equipment being dropped off should be dropped at the office not the classroom.

Pupils Yr4 above must wear a mask inside and on the bus if you are a bus pupil. Please name these. Masks are not needed outdoors but must maintain other good practises (sanitising, social distancing) Interschool sports have been cancelled in RED
